Good Morning Ben,

I believe right now the charge is our MSW Tipping Fee (\$63) + the Special handling Fee of \$150/load
If you brought in a transfer trailer of 20 Tons + the \$150 it would be ~\$70.50/ton.
However, currently we would need to confirm your proposed volume and our ability to handle it, prior to delivery.

In the future, if this was like 90%+ dry and could be landfilled directly, and not composted (which is what happens now), we could arrange for a different pricing structure to reflect that reduced handling/disposal cost.

I should be able to confirm a date for a site visit shortly to Rio Vista, for you all to see a technology that we are considering for our own processes. The proposed dates are the first, third, or fourth week of July. Which of those is better for you all?
