RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF VISALIA AUTHORIZING THE CITY OF VISALIA TO ACCEPT AN AWARD FROM THE BOARD OF STATE AND COMMUNITY CORRECTIONS (BSCC) BOARD OF THE CALIFORNIA VIOLENCE INTERVENTION AND PREVENTION (CAL VIP)

CAL VIP GRANT PROGRAM

WHEREAS, the City of Visalia desires to accept an award from the Board of State and Community Corrections (BSCC) Board of the California Violence Intervention and Prevention (Cal VIP) in the amount of \$2,000,000. The City of Visalia will utilize the funds to support youth and families affected by violence, including those experiencing geographic or economic challenges; and

WHEREAS, the City of Visalia was awarded grant funding and determined to allocate some of the funding to support recreation programs; and

WHEREAS, the City of Visalia received a notification of a Subrecipient from the Board of State and Community Corrections (BSCC) Board of the California Violence Intervention and Prevention (Cal VIP) for a total of \$2,000,000;

WHEREAS, the Grant performance period is April 1, 2026, to January 30, 2029;

WHEREAS, the grant funds received hereunder shall not be used to supplant expenditures controlled by this body;

WHEREAS, there are no cost-sharing or match requirements for the Program;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Visalia City Council has reviewed and hereby accepts the award Agreement Regarding the Board of State and Community Corrections (BSCC) Board of the California Violence Intervention and Prevention (Cal VIP) Grant Programs Funding for Visalia Parks and Recreation Programs and additional local organizations to deliver complementary services.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the City Manager for the City of Visalia is authorized to execute on behalf of the Council of the City of Visalia the Award Agreement, including any extensions or amendments thereof, and any subsequent contract with the State in relation to these grant funds.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, the City of Visalia hereby agrees to review, adhere to, and comply with all County, State, and Federal Grant award requirements.
