

RESOLUTION NO. 2026 - 1

A RESOLUTION OF THE VISALIA CITY COUNCIL
ACCEPTING A PORTION OF CITY OWNED
PROPERTY INTO THE PUBLIC STREET SYSTEM

WHEREAS, the City of Visalia, State of California, owns real property, intended for a future park along with portions of it to be utilized for a sidewalk and other public purposes, including but not limited to setback from the currently designated public streets, designated as a "Lot A" per Elliott Subdivision Phase 1 Final Map; located at the southwest corner of Roeben Street and Howard Avenue in the City of Visalia; and

WHEREAS, the City of Visalia desires to accept three portions of Lot "A" into the public street system, with the total size of the three portions of land totaling approximately 427 square feet; and

WHEREAS, said portions are more particularly described in Attachment "A" legal description of the three portions and Attachment "B" a diagram depicting the location of the three portions being accepted into the public street system as part of those areas referred to as Howard Avenue and Roeben Street; and

WHEREAS, Section 1806(b) of the California Streets and Highways Code states that no public or private street or road shall become a city street or road until the governing body, by resolution, has caused the street or road to be accepted into the city street system; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to state law requirements, the City Council may by resolution authorize the acceptance of a portion of a public street or road into the public street system.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED AS FOLLOWS:

1. The City of Visalia, does hereby accept into the public street system the above-described three portions of City-owned property, totaling approximately 427 square feet of Lot A of the Elliott Subdivision Phase 1 Final Map, into the City of Visalia public street system.
