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## **I. DEFINITIONS**

For the purposes of RFB NO. 22-23-23, the following terms shall have the meanings indicated:

1. "City" means the City of Visalia
2. "City Council" means the Council of the City of Visalia
3. "Bidder", "Vendor", "Supplier", "Consultant", "Contractor" and "Subrecipient" are used interchangeably throughout this invitation to mean the person, firm, or corporation or other entity submitting a Bid in response to the Request for Bid.
4. "Bid" and "Proposal" are used interchangeably to mean an individual's or entity's offer in response to this Request for Bid.
5. "RFB" means Request for Bid No. 22-23-23.

## **II. INTRODUCTION**

The City of Visalia Purchasing Division is soliciting Bids for an annual contract for steam cleaning services at City owned bus shelters/stops.

The initial contract shall be for a twelve (12) month period and shall, at the City's option and upon mutually agreeable terms, be renewable annually thereafter for four (4) consecutive one-year periods. Bids are being sought from contractors who have a proven record of experience in providing the services required by this Invitation to Bid.

The successful bidder shall be responsible for providing all services necessary to fulfill the requirements of this Invitation to Bid upon receipt of the City's Notice to Proceed.

Local Vendor Preference In an effort to encourage local businesses to provide goods and services to the City, Council has enacted a local preference. The local preference will apply to any business that has a business address within Tulare County for a minimum of six months. A Post Office Box will not be accepted as a business address. The City reserves the right to request proof of Tulare County address.

The local preference for bids consists of a match preference in which a local vendor whose bid is within 5% of the apparent low bidder will be given three (3) business days, from date notified, to match or beat the low bid. If there is more than one local vendor that is within the 5% range, the offer goes to the local vendor that is closest to the low bid.

Executive Order N-6-22 – Russia Sanctions: On March 4, 2022, Governor Gavin Newsom issued Executive Order N-6-22 (the EO) regarding Economic Sanctions against Russia and Russian entities and individuals. "Economic Sanctions" refers to sanctions imposed by the U.S. government in response to Russia's actions in Ukraine, as well as any sanctions imposed under state law. By submitting a bid or proposal, Contractor represents that it is not a target of Economic Sanctions. Should the State determine Contractor is a target of Economic Sanctions or is conducting prohibited transactions with sanctioned individuals or entities, that shall be grounds for rejection of the Contractor's bid/proposal any time prior to contract execution, or, if determined after contract execution, shall be grounds for termination by the State.

The City hereby affirmatively ensures that Minority Business Enterprises and Disadvantaged Business Enterprises (DBE) will be afforded full opportunity to submit proposals in response to this notice. Individuals and/or entities submitting bids/proposals to the City of Visalia will not be discriminated against on the basis of race, religion, color, national origin, ancestry, physical or mental disability, medical condition, genetic information, marital status, gender, gender identity or expression, sexual orientation, or military and veteran status in any consideration leading to the award of contract.

No qualified disabled person shall, on the basis of disability, be excluded from participating in, be denied the benefits of, or otherwise be subjected to discrimination under any program or activity leading to the award of a contract.

4. Submit each of the required Certifications, Affidavits, Statements and Questionnaires as well as optional waiver(s) to City with the sealed Bid. City will not consider Bids which are not accompanied by the required completed forms.

#### **IV. SCOPE OF SERVICES/PROJECT**

##### **1. OVERVIEW**

The Scope of Services described in this section is a general guide and is not intended to be a complete list of all work and materials necessary to complete the project or supply goods or services. The Scope of Services contains work tasks required for the steam cleaning and maintenance of Bus Shelters and Bus Stops that meets Visalia Transit's Requirements. Visalia Transit operates thirteen (13) routes that service City of Visalia, City of Farmersville, City of Exeter, and Goshen. Our service operates from 6:00 a.m. to 10:30 p.m. on weekdays and from 7:30 a.m. to 8:00 p.m. on weekends.

##### **2. GENERAL REQUIREMENTS**

###### **a. Service**

The Contractor shall provide Services necessary to steam clean and maintain Bus Shelters and Hard Surface Bus Stops. Visalia Transit Bus Shelters and Bus Stops are composed of items, such as trash receptacles, signs, benches, concrete surfaces, etc. (hereinafter "Visalia Transit Customer Amenities"). The Contractor shall be responsible for providing all labor, materials, tools, equipment, supplies, clean-up, disposal, and services to maintain the Visalia Transit Customer Amenities. The Contractor shall provide the Services within the boundaries of the Visalia Transit service area of Visalia, Goshen, Farmersville, and Exeter unless otherwise specified.

###### **b. Compliance**

The Contractor shall furnish all Services and equipment as specified in this Scope of Services and shall comply with all technical specifications, terms, warranty conditions, and schedule requirements.

###### **c. Goals of Service**

The Contractor shall make provisions, including equipment and personnel, to perform the Schedule of tasks in the time frames required by this Scope of Services. The Services provided by the Contractor shall contribute to Visalia Transit's vision of providing a clean, safe, reliable, quality, and cost-effective transportation system.

### **3. SHELTER AND BUS STOP CLEANING SERVICE**

The Contractor shall maintain the cleanliness of approximately 510 bus stops located within the City of Visalia, City of Farmersville, City of Exeter, and Goshen on a regular schedule. See Appendix "A" for a list of current Visalia Transit stops covered under this Contract. Not all stops will need to be serviced on a regular basis but may need to be serviced as outlined below in "Emergency Service."

#### **a. Number of Shelters**

Visalia Transit has erected shelters at many of its Bus Stop locations for the protection of its customers from adverse weather conditions. The Contractor shall maintain the cleanliness and remove all trash at approximately 122 bus shelters located within the City of Visalia weekly, 1 bus shelter located in Goshen bi-weekly, 9 bus shelters within the City of Farmersville bi-weekly, and 1 bus shelter within the City of Exeter bi-weekly. See Appendix "A" for a list of current stops with shelters covered under this Contract. Each of these locations includes a shelter with a bench either attached or separate, trash receptacles, sign pole, signs, and schedule holder. Visalia Transit may add or remove 15 shelters per year. The Visalia Transit Project Manager shall notify (via email) the Contractor of any removal or installation of shelters being put in or removed from service. The Contractor shall provide services for additional shelters added to this Contract by Visalia Transit during the term of the Contract at the unit cost provided on the Bid Form.

#### **b. Number of Stops with Trash Receptacles Only**

Visalia Transit has only trash receptacles at some of its Bus Stop locations. The Contractor shall empty all trash receptacles and replace liners of approximately 45 bus shelters located within the City of Visalia weekly and 2 bus shelters located in the City of Farmersville bi-weekly. Trash receptacles added to any stops in Goshen or City of Exeter in the future shall be covered under this contract and serviced on a bi-weekly schedule. See Appendix "A" for a list of current bus stops with only trash receptacles covered under this Contract. Each of these locations includes trash receptacles, sign pole, signs, and schedule holder. Visalia Transit may add or remove 15 trash receptacles per year. The Visalia Transit Project Manager shall notify (via email) the Contractor of any removal or installation of shelters being put in or removed from service. The Contractor shall provide services for such additional trash receptacles added to this Contract by Visalia Transit during the term of the Contract at the unit cost provided on the Bid Form.

#### **c. Emergency Service**

Periodically, there will be a need for the Contractor to respond to an emergency call for service. The Contractor shall provide Emergency Service by responding to the requested location with the resources and providing the requested Emergency Service within twelve (12) hours from the time Visalia Transit notifies contractor (the "Emergency Service"). The Project Manager shall be the Visalia Transit point of contact for requesting Emergency Service unless otherwise designated. This expectation ensures no hesitation or delay in Service.

### **4. QUALITY**

The Contractor shall maintain the shelters, hard surface bus stops, and the surrounding area(s) to present a clean and neat appearance. As a quality standard, the shelters and bus stops should complement the community and provide a clean safe area for customers to wait to alight and disembark a Visalia Transit bus. Shelters and bus stops that are unsightly and disheveled cause safety concerns for Visalia Transit customers.

#### **a. Schedule**

The Contractor shall clean each bus shelter and trash receptacle in Visalia once each week and those in Goshen, Farmersville, and Exeter once every two (2) weeks pursuant to a cleaning schedule (the "Schedule") containing the bus stops as set forth in Appendix "B", as submitted by the Contractor to Visalia Transit for approval. The Schedule shall show all the Shelters and Bus Stops in approximately location-based order for easy execution and monitoring. The Contractor shall submit a written schedule for approval

no more than seven (7) days from the execution of this Contract. The Contractor shall be responsible for supplying the schedule based upon date and time of service and location. The supplied schedule shall be used to provide efficient service, and the Contractor will be responsible to adhere to it. Visalia Transit will monitor the schedule to ensure that services are being performed by the Contractor. Visalia Transit reserves the right to modify this schedule to add, change or delete the quantity, frequency of service and locations of pressure washing of shelters and bus stops as necessary. The Contractor will be notified (via email) in advance of changes to the schedule by Visalia Transit.

#### Missed Stops

It is the contractor's responsibility to ensure that all stops are serviced as described herein and per the schedule submitted by the contractor. If the schedule changes in any way, it is the contractor's responsibility to update the Project Manager or their designee of the change. If stops are not serviced per the schedule provided by contractor, or the specifications herein, the contractor shall perform the service within twelve (12) hours from the time Visalia Transit notifies the contractor of the missed service. No additional payment shall be issued for this service.

### **5. SPECIFICATIONS FOR BUS SHELTER AND HARD SURFACE BUS STOP SERVICE**

Each bus shelter/stop shall be cleaned once per week in the Visalia area and once every two (2) weeks in the surrounding communities served by Visalia Transit. Contractor will establish the day and time of cleaning described herein. The following services shall be performed at each location listed on Appendix "B" Bus Shelter/Stops Locations:

- a. Remove any trash, litter, or debris around bus stop area.
- b. All gum and stains are to be removed from the concrete.
- c. Empty all trash receptacles and replace liners. Report any missing or damaged trashcan cages or receptacles to Project Manager. Dispose of all trash and waste products within fifteen (15) feet of the outer edge of the bus shelter or bus stop. All trash must be disposed of at the expense of the contractor.
- d. Clean the exterior of all trash receptacles using a disinfectant type of cleaner.
- e. Dispose of any drug paraphernalia as required per the Health and Safety code.
- f. Provide any plastic trash can liners needed (30-gallon size)
- g. Contractor shall report any damage or safety hazards to the shelter or stop amenities to the Project Manager within 24 hours after the stop has been serviced.
- h. Remove graffiti on shelters, signs, and schedule holders within fifteen (15) feet of sidewalk surrounding the shelter/stop with a cleaner approved by the City.
- i. In addition, it is the responsibility of the Contractor to ensure that proper maintenance of traffic is followed when cleaning the shelters and bus stops. City of Visalia Transit will not pay for tickets or fines associated with improper maintenance of traffic.
- j. Contractor shall provide a supervisor and adequate staff to complete the full shelter list weekly for Visalia locations, bi-weekly for outlying areas (Goshen, Exeter, and Farmersville).
- k. Contractor shall maintain records of cleaning locations/times/dates, to be submitted monthly with invoice to Transit staff.
- l. Bus Stops with Shelters:
  - (1) The Contractor shall have steam cleaning equipment able to produce 230 degree water, operate at 4,000 PSI and evenly apply the pressure from 1" above the surface and provide documentation of such equipment at the start of the contract.
  - (2) It is the responsibility of the Contractor to ensure that if chemicals are used in steam cleaning of shelters and bus stops, all proper guidelines for containment of disposal

of the associated wastewater are followed.

- (3) The entirety of a bus shelter and bus stop shall be steam cleaned. This includes shelter poles, concrete pad, shelter seats, the roof structure (top and bottom), glass and Plexiglas ad panels, etc. All structures are to be steam cleaned to remove dirt/stains and graffiti with no visible streaks. In addition, any paper attached to the shelter, bus stop pole or flag shall be removed prior to steam cleaning.
- (4) Any roof mounted solar panel shall be cleaned along with the bus stop pole and sign.
- (5) Other amenities in addition to the shelter shall also be cleaned. These include the hopper on trash compactors, trashcans, benches, and bike racks.
- (6) Pressure wash shelters & solar panels while using a bio-degradable cleaner (on shelters) as needed.

## **6. SAFETY AND EFFICIENCY REQUIREMENTS FOR CONTRACTOR**

The following is a list of safety requirements to which the Contractor shall adhere:

- a. Contractor's employees shall wear proper personal protective equipment (PPE) when performing tasks which can result in personal injury (e.g., wearing of safety gloves and eye protection).
- b. The Contractor shall abide by all local and State motor vehicle traffic laws and regulations while in the performance of services for Visalia Transit.
- c. The Contractor shall abide by all OSHA regulations and always observe worker safety precautions while in performance of services for Visalia Transit.
- d. The Contractor's vehicles shall be equipped with safety amber flashing lights. Traffic cones shall be set up and the Contractor's employees shall wear orange safety vests while working on or near road right of ways.
- e. All work must be performed in a clean, orderly, and professional fashion and shall not cause any inconvenience to or interfere with Visalia Transit customers, employees, or bus operations/service.
- f. When on duty at Visalia Transit work sites, the Contractor's employee(s) shall always present a clean and tidy appearance and be clothed in a standard uniform to be supplied by the Contractor. Visalia Transit reserves the right to have the Contractor's employees removed from the work site if they do not meet the standards listed above, including safety standards.
- g. The Contractor shall submit before the start of the Contract, and upon subsequent request, Material Safety Data Sheets ("MSDS") and labels for chemicals and cleaning products utilized at Visalia Transit locations during this contract. All chemicals used shall be safe for people and preferably biodegradable. MSDS information submitted to Visalia Transit shall include the reporting requirements of Section 313, Title III of the Superfund Amendments and Re-authorization Act (SARA) and 40 CFR, Part 372.
- h. If Contractor changes any chemicals used in conjunction with this Contract, the Contractor must submit MSDS information and Technical Product Bulletins to Visalia Transit before the chemicals are used by the Contractor.
- i. Reporting and Invoicing Requirements. A completed Quality Check form set forth in Appendix "C" shall be submitted with all invoices. Any deviations from the Schedule submitted by contractor shall be reported monthly. The approval of invoices for payment by Visalia Transit shall be based on the Quality Check form submitted by the Contractor and the audit results of the completed services. Invoices will not be paid without a completed Quality Check form identifying each Bus Stop service during the invoice period. Visalia Transit will not pay for any Bus Stops serviced that are not identified on the Quality Check form submitted with the invoice. The invoice shall include the actual date and time of service rendered associated with bus shelter and/or hard surface bus stop.

**V. PRE-BID AND CONTRACT MEETINGS**

1. A Non - Mandatory Pre-Bid Meeting. A non-mandatory pre-Bid meeting will be held on **Tuesday, November 29, 2022, at 10:00 a.m.** at City Hall West, 707 W. Acequia Ave. Attendance at this meeting is not required to submit a Bid in response to this RFB but is encouraged. Information regarding the project will be provided at that time. It shall be the responsibility of the Contractor to have acquired full knowledge of the job site, scope of work and any problems or difficulties that may affect the work proposed.
2. Post Award Meeting. Subsequent to the award of contract, the Contractor shall meet with the Project Manager prior to the start of work to discuss any problems or questions that may arise. Contractor shall contact the Project Manager within ten (10) days of the date of the Notice to Proceed to arrange this meeting.

**VI. BID OPENING AND CONFIDENTIALITY**

1. Bid Opening. Bids shall be opened publicly in the presence of attendees, if any, on **Tuesday, December 13, 2022, at 2:00 p.m.** at 707 W. Acequia, Visalia CA, City Hall. The name of each Bidder and the amount of each Bid shall be open to public inspection at the Bid opening and after an award decision has been made. Other Bid information will not be available for public review during the evaluation phase.
2. Bid Confidentiality. The City favors full and open disclosure of all Bid records. The City will not expend public funds defending claims for access to, inspection of, or to be provided copies of any such records. By submitting a Bid, a Bidder agrees to indemnify and defend the City against all claims or actions brought against it to seek access to, or compel disclosure of, any records or documents in the City's possession.

After the award, the City intends that its selection process will be open and public. Respondents are advised that the California Public Records Act ("PRA") provides that any person may inspect or be provided a copy of any identifiable public record or document that is not exempted from disclosure by the express provisions of the Act. The Federal Freedom of Information Act ("FOIA") contains a similar provision. Each Bidder shall clearly identify any information within its Bid that it intends to ask the City to withhold as exempt under either the PRA or FOIA. Any information contained in a Bidder's submission which the Bidder believe qualifies for exemption from public disclosure as "Proprietary" or "Confidential" must be identified as such at the time of first submission of Bidder's Bid to this RFB. Any failure to identify information contained in a Bidder's Bid to this RFB as "Proprietary" or "Confidential" shall constitute a waiver of Bidder's right to object to the release of such information upon request under either Act.

**VII. AWARD**

1. Most Responsive, Responsible Bidder. A Contract (substantially similar to that attached hereto as Exhibit "C" with Attachments 1-2) shall be awarded with reasonable promptness by appropriate written notice. Award shall be made to the most responsive, responsible Bidder whose Proposal meets the requirements and criteria set forth in this RFB, price and other factors considered, and whose Bid is determined to result in the optimum economic advantage to the City. A responsible Bidder is one who has the capability, financial capacity and integrity to perform the contract. A responsive Bidder is one who commits to all of the material terms, for example, price, quantity, quality and delivery, of this RFB. Contractor must return a signed copy of the contract provided by the City with its Award Notice to City within ten (10) working days of receipt thereof.
2. Reservation of Rights. The City reserves the right to reject any item or items in the Bid; to waive informalities, technical defects, and minor irregularities in Bids received; and to select the Bid(s) deemed most advantageous to the City.

## **VIII. PROTESTS/APPEALS**

Because it is essential that Bidders have confidence in the procurement procedures for soliciting and awarding contracts, it is the policy of the City to offer Bidders the opportunity to appeal award of contracts. The following procedures shall apply in regard to appeals:

1. Any actual Bidder who is aggrieved in connection with this RFB or award of a contract hereunder may protest to the City of Visalia Purchasing Division in writing within five (5) working days after such aggrieved Bidder knows, should have reasonably known, or could reasonably be expected to know of the facts giving rise thereto; and
2. Should identify only the areas regarding bid contradictions, procurement errors, quotation rating discrepancies, legality of procurement context, conflict of interest in the rating process and inappropriate or unfair competitive procurement grievance regarding the Bid process.
3. The City's Purchasing Division shall have the authority to settle and resolve each protest. The resolution will be provided to Bidder in writing within five (5) working days of receipt of the appeal unless the Bidder is notified more time is required.
4. Further levels of appeal may be made in accordance with the appeals provision contained in Chapter 5 of the City's "Purchasing and Contract Procedures" which is available through City's Purchasing Division.

## **IX. SPECIAL CONDITIONS**

1. Project Administrative Issues
  - a. Complete Project. The successful Bidder shall be responsible for providing all materials, labor, equipment and services necessary to fulfill the requirements of this RFB. It is the intent of this RFB and related agreement to describe a functionally complete project.
  - b. Quantities/Change Orders. The City reserves and shall have the right to make such changes to the work as may be necessary and desirable to complete the work originally intended in an acceptable manner. Unless otherwise specified herein, the Project Manager shall be and is hereby authorized to make such changes, with the approval of the Purchasing Division, in the work as may increase or decrease the originally awarded contract quantities and/or total contract cost. The Contract Price or the amount due the Contractor will only be reduced/increased after the price change is reviewed and authorized by the Project Manager.
  - c. Omitted Items. Project Manager is authorized to omit minor contract items. Major items must be omitted by supplemental agreement.
  - d. Extra Work. Contractor is prohibited from doing extra work, unless authorized in writing by Project Manager before the work is done. Payment for approved Extra Work shall be as agreed to in writing by the Project Manager prior to the Extra Work being completed. No additional payment is due for unauthorized Extra Work.
2. City-Contractor Relations
  - a. Project Manager's Responsibility and Authority. City will designate a Project Manager. All work shall be done under the general supervision of such Project Manager or his or her designee(s). The Project Manager shall decide issues of quality and acceptability of materials, work performance, rate of progress of work, interpretation of specifications, and all questions related to fulfillment of the contract for the project. Project Manager shall not have control over acts or omissions of the Contractor, Subcontractors, their agents or employees.
  - b. Contractor/Contractor's Superintendent. Contractor shall bear all responsibility for, and have all control over, the construction means, methods, techniques, sequences, procedures and safety precautions or programs related to the project. Contractor may designate a superintendent.
  - c. Project Site/Existing Structures. Contractor shall take care to avoid, but shall be

responsible for, all damage to existing structures, including, but not limited to, sewers, water service, drains and culverts, underground utilities, and the like.

d. Labor

(1) Workmanship. Workmanship shall be equal to the best general janitorial practice.

(2) Qualification. Contractor shall ensure that each employee who works on this project is qualified to perform their assigned duty in a safe manner.

e. Storage of Materials. Materials shall be stored to ensure the preservation of their quality and fitness for the project.

f. Legal Responsibilities. It is the responsibility of Contractor to comply with all local, state, and federal laws and regulations which apply to this project. This includes, but is not limited to, compliance with Uniform Building, Plumbing, Mechanical, Electric, and Fire Codes. Contractor shall provide a safe working environment in compliance with the Occupational Safety and Health Act, and California Health and Safety Codes. Additionally, Contractor shall secure all necessary permits, licenses, and similar requirements to carry out the project. Contractor shall comply with all applicable labor laws and ensure against discrimination.

**X. GENERAL CONDITIONS**

1. It is the policy of the City to provide equal opportunity to all candidates when selecting Bidders to provide public services. Bidders are expected to be equal opportunity employers.

The City hereby affirmatively ensures that Minority Business Enterprises and Disadvantaged Business Enterprises (DBE) will be afforded full opportunity to submit proposals in response to this notice. Individuals and/or entities submitting bids/proposals to the City of Visalia will not be discriminated against on the basis of race, religion, color, national origin, ancestry, physical or mental disability, medical condition, genetic information, marital status, gender, gender identity or expression, sexual orientation, or military and veteran status in any consideration leading to the award of contract.

No qualified disabled person shall, on the basis of disability, be excluded from participating in, be denied the benefits of, or otherwise be subjected to discrimination under any program or activity that receives or benefits from Federal financial assistance.

Bidder shall provide to the City a list of all instances within the last ten (10) years where a complaint was filed or pending against Bidder in a legal or administrative proceeding alleging that Bidder discriminated against its employees, subcontractors, vendors or suppliers. A description of the status or resolution of that complaint, including any remedial action taken is required.

2. Post-Closing Date Corrections are prohibited.

3. Bids will not be accepted unless signed in ink (not typed) in the appropriate space(s) by an authorized officer or employee of the Bidder.

4. Bids must be submitted on or before the Closing Date. Any Bids received after the Closing Date shall be returned, unopened, to the Bidder, provided the request number, opening date, and Bidder's return address are on the envelope.

5. Bids may be withdrawn prior to the Bid Closing Date by writing to the Purchasing Division.

6. Telegraphic, telephonic, electronic and facsimile Bids and withdrawal requests will not be accepted.

7. Prices submitted are considered accurate for a period of ninety (90) days and cannot be withdrawn after the Closing Date.

8. All Bids are the property of the City after submission.

9. City is not responsible for Bid errors and omissions.

10. Bids should be prepared in a straightforward, concise manner. Information provided which was not specifically requested will be considered only in City's discretion.
11. A written amendment or addenda issued by City's Purchasing Division is the only method which should be relied on with respect to changes to the RFB. Respondent is responsible to contact City's Purchasing Division prior to submitting a Bid to determine if any amendments were made to the RFB.
12. Prior to conducting business in the City, a business tax certificate (license) must be obtained. Call (559) 713-4326 for more information.
13. Bidder shall provide insurance as required by law and as indicated in the proposed contract.
14. Bidder shall maintain all personnel files and payroll records for employees used to implement the proposed contract.
15. Bidder shall withhold, pay and report all taxes and issue W-2 forms at the end of each calendar year for employees used to implement the proposed contract.
16. Pursuant to the City's Charter, all other things being equal, tie Bids shall be awarded to a local merchant to the extent quality and prices are equal. If neither is a local vendor, the Bid shall be awarded by the flip of a coin by the Purchasing Division in the presence of at least one witness.
17. The City may make such investigation of the Bidder and information in the Bid as it determines necessary. This may include the collection of criminal history information, contractual and business associations and practices, employment histories and reputation.
18. All California agencies may purchase off the Proposal submitted at the same prices, terms, conditions and specifications. The City of Visalia shall incur no responsibility in connection with another agency's purchase.
19. Each Bidder will be required to submit Certifications, Affidavits, Assurances, Statements and Questionnaires which are attached in Exhibit "B".
20. The quantities given on the Bid Proposal form and any related contract documents are approximate only. They are given as a basis for comparison of Bids. The City of Visalia does not, expressly or impliedly agree that the actual amount of work will correspond therewith, but reserves the right to increase or decrease the amount of any class or portion of work, or to omit portion of the work, as the City deems necessary or advisable, at the prices Bid.
21. Bidders shall satisfy themselves by personal examination of the work site, specifications, plans, and other contract documents and by any other means as they believe necessary, as to the actual physical conditions, requirements, and difficulties under which the project must be performed. The submission of a Bid shall be conclusive evidence that the Bidder has investigated, and is satisfied as to the conditions encountered, as to the character, quality, and quantities of work to be performed, and the materials to be furnished, and as to the requirements of the RFB and the City. No allowance shall subsequently be made because of lack of such examination or knowledge.
22. All Bidders are required to make a Bid on the complete Bid Form (Exhibit "A"). Contractor may be required to submit Proposals on alternate items. The City reserves the right to award to the contract based on the lowest combination or combinations of Proposal items and alternate proposed items.
23. No mention shall be made in the Proposal of sales tax, use tax or any other tax, as all amounts Bid will be deemed and held to include any such taxes, which may be applicable.
24. Only one Bid may be submitted as a "Prime Contractor" for the same work by any firm, individual, partnership, corporation or combination thereof. A Contractor submitting a Bid as a Prime Contractor may not also submit sub-Bids to other competing Prime Contractors. Reasonable grounds for believing that any individual, firm, partnership, corporation or combination thereof is interested in more than one Proposal for the work contemplated will cause the rejection of all Proposals in which such individual, firm, partnership, corporation or combination thereof is interested. A Contractor who is not submitting a Bid as a Prime

Contractor may submit any number of sub-Bids to competing Prime Contractors.

25. The City of Visalia is not liable for any costs incurred by Bidder in responding to this Request for Bid.
26. The annual contract resulting from this invitation to bid will be jointly administered by the Transit and Purchasing Departments. However, the City's Purchasing Division shall be the final judge concerning issues or matters related to contract interpretation or problems regarding the terms, conditions or scope of the contract.
27. The initial contract term shall be for a twelve (12) month period and shall, at the City's option and with the consent of the CONTRACTOR, be extended annually thereafter for four (4) consecutive one-year periods. Contract shall begin no later than 15 days from the receipt of annual contract.
28. All prices quoted in response to this Invitation to Bid shall be firm and fixed for twelve (12) months from the annual anniversary date of the agreement. In order to protect the interests of the City and to give the vendor a reasonable basis for bidding, a price adjustment feature is hereby incorporated into the specifications. Prices bid by vendor may be adjusted annually at time of contract renewal and upon mutual agreement of the parties to the contract to allow for price increases or decreases for labor and benefit rates, supplies and materials.

It will be the responsibility of the contractor to request a price adjustment and to provide all documentation necessary. The request for price adjustment must be submitted to the Project Manager in writing a minimum of thirty (30) but no sooner than ninety (90) calendar days prior to the annual anniversary date of the agreement. Requests filed after this time period will not be considered.

The unit prices for the ensuing contracts shall be based on the movement of the unadjusted figures of the U.S. Department of Labor Consumer Price Index (CPI) for all Urban Consumers (CPI-U All Cities Average). The contract unit prices may be changed in an amount equal to the percentage of movement for the most recent twelve-month period. In no instance shall the price increase exceed 5%. The contract unit price changes as a result of this formula shall be binding on the contractor for the subsequent contract year. The adjustment of the unit bid price shall not be retroactive and shall apply only to changes incurred after approval.

29. This contract may be terminated without cause by the City, in whole or in part, by giving the Contractor fifteen (15) days written notice of the intent to terminate whenever the City determines that termination is in the best interest of the City.

If the Contractor shall fail to provide services or perform satisfactorily the work required by the terms and conditions of the contract, or materially breaches any of its obligations under this agreement the City may terminate the contract, in whole or in part by written notice. Termination shall take effect ten (10) calendar days after the date of mailing said termination notice.

Any assignment, subletting or transfer of the interest of the contractor, either in whole or in part, without the written consent of the City shall be cause for the City to immediately terminate the agreement for default.

Notwithstanding any other provisions of this agreement, this agreement may be terminated by the City upon a single violation of this agreement.

## **XI. POST AWARD RESPONSIBILITIES**

1. Written Contract with City. A written agreement in a form similar to that attached to this Request for Bid as Exhibit "C" with Attachments 1-2 must be entered into between the City and the Contractor to whom the project is awarded. The Agreement forms the basis for the contractual obligation between the parties regarding the project. A contract will be provided with the Notice of Award and must be executed and returned to City within ten (10) working days of the date of award notification unless otherwise agreed.
2. Post-Award Responsibilities. Upon execution of the Agreement between the City and the

Contractor, the Contractor shall immediately report all changes in its Articles of Incorporation, By-Laws, or Tax-Exempt status to the City.

3. Insurance. Contractor shall obtain and maintain the minimum insurance coverage outlined Exhibit "C", Attachment 2. Contractor shall provide evidence of such insurance to City's Purchasing Division prior to commencement of work.

Upon determination by the City that a contract has been entered and Contractor has provided all of the information that it is required to provide pursuant to this RFB, City will issue, in writing, a notice to proceed on the project to Contractor.

Prices bid by vendor may be adjusted annually at time of contract renewal and upon mutual agreement of the parties to the contract to allow for price increases or decreases for labor and benefit rates, supplies and materials.

It will be the responsibility of the contractor to request a price adjustment and to provide all documentation necessary. The request for price adjustment must be submitted to the project manager in writing a minimum of thirty (30) but no sooner than ninety (90) calendar days prior to the annual anniversary date of the agreement. Requests filed after this time-period will not be considered.

The unit prices for the ensuing contracts shall be based on the movement of the unadjusted figures of the U.S. Department of Labor Consumer Price Index (CPI) for all Urban Consumers (CPI-U All Cities Average). The contract unit prices may be changed in an amount equal to the percentage of movement for the twelve-month period ending in the month of December of each contract year. In no instance shall the price increase exceed 5%. The contracts unit price changes as a result of this formula shall be binding on the contractor for the subsequent contract year. The adjustment of the unit bid price shall not be retroactive and shall apply only to changes incurred after approval.

GENERAL CONTRACT PROVISIONS

- A. Successors and Assigns: This Agreement shall be binding upon and shall inure to the benefit of any successors to or assigns of the parties.
- B. Prohibition of Assignment: Neither party shall assign, delegate or transfer their rights and duties in this Agreement without the written consent of the other party.
- C. Notices: Notice shall be sufficient hereunder if personally served upon the City Clerk of the CITY or an officer or principal of the CONTRACTOR, or if sent via the United States Postal Service, postage prepaid, addressed as follows:

- D. Independent Contractor: It is understood and agreed by the parties herein that CONTRACTOR, in the performance of this Agreement, shall act as an independent contractor, and therefore shall obtain no rights to any fringe benefits that accrue to regular full-time CITY employees.
- E. Jurisdiction/Venue/Waiver of Removal: This Agreement shall be administered and interpreted under the laws of the State of California. Jurisdiction of litigation arising from this Agreement shall be in California. Any action brought to interpret or enforce this Agreement, or any of the terms or conditions hereof, shall be brought in Tulare County, California. The CONTRACTOR hereby expressly waives any right to remove any action to a county other than Tulare County as permitted pursuant to Section 394 of the California Code of Civil Procedure.
- F. Integration/Modification: This Agreement and each of the documents and exhibits or attachments referenced herein, which are incorporated by reference, represents the entire understanding of the parties as to those matters contained herein. No prior oral or written understanding shall be of any force or effect with respect to those matters covered hereunder. This Agreement may not be modified or altered except in writing signed by the parties, unless otherwise explicitly authorized.
- G. Conflict With Law: If any part of this Agreement is found to be in conflict with applicable laws, such part shall be inoperative, null and void insofar as it is in conflict with said law, but the remainder of the Agreement shall be in full force and effect.
- H. Indemnification: The CONTRACTOR waives any and all claims and recourse against the CITY, including the right of contribution of loss or damage to person or property arising from, growing out of, or in any way connected with or incidental to the CONTRACTOR's performance of this Agreement, except claims arising from the concurrent or sole negligence of the CITY or its officers, agents or employees. The CONTRACTOR will indemnify, hold harmless, and defend (at CITY's option) the CITY against any and all claims, demands, damages, costs, expenses, or liability arising out of the CONTRACTOR's performance of this Agreement except for liability arising out of the concurrent or sole negligence of the CITY or its officers, agents, or employees.
- I. Attorney's Fees: In the event either party commences any action, arbitration or legal proceedings for the enforcement of this Agreement, the prevailing party, as determined by the court or arbitrator, shall be entitled to recovery of its attorney's fees and court costs incurred in the action brought thereon.
- J. Headings: Section headings are provided for organizational purposes only and do not in any manner affect the scope or intent of the provisions thereunder.
- K. Firearms Prohibited: Guns may not be carried by contractors/vendors/consultants while working on City of Visalia premises without the expressed written approval of a City of Visalia Department

Head, or an exemption in the contract. If a contractor/vendor/consultant is caught carrying a gun, without City permission, their contract will be terminated.

L. Executive Order N-6-22 – Russia Sanctions

On March 4, 2022, Governor Gavin Newsom issued Executive Order N-6-22 (the EO) regarding Economic Sanctions against Russia and Russian entities and individuals. “Economic Sanctions” refers to sanctions imposed by the U.S. government in response to Russia’s actions in Ukraine, as well as any sanctions imposed under state law. The EO directs state agencies to terminate contracts with, and to refrain from entering any new contracts with, individuals or entities that are determined to be a target of Economic Sanctions. Accordingly, should the State determine Contractor is a target of Economic Sanctions or is conducting prohibited transactions with sanctioned individuals or entities, that shall be grounds for termination of this agreement. The State shall provide Contractor advance written notice of such termination, allowing Contractor at least 30 calendar days to provide a written response. Termination shall be at the sole discretion of the State.

INSURANCE REQUIREMENTS

1. CONTRACTOR Insurance. CONTRACTOR, at its sole cost and expense, for the full term of this Agreement (and any extensions thereof), shall obtain and maintain at a minimum compliance with all of the following insurance coverage(s) and requirements. Such insurance coverage shall be primary coverage as respects CITY and any insurance or self-insurance maintained by CITY shall be in excess of CONTRACTOR’s insurance coverage and shall not contribute to it.
2. Subcontractor(s) Insurance. If CONTRACTOR utilizes one or more subcontractors in the performance of this Agreement, CONTRACTOR shall obtain and maintain independent insurance as to each subcontractor or otherwise provide evidence of insurance coverage for each subcontractor equivalent to that required of CONTRACTOR.
3. Types of Insurance and Minimum Limits. The following types of insurance and minimum limits are required providing at least the following minimum coverage and limits of liability:
  - a. Worker’s Compensation written in accordance with the laws of the State of California providing coverage for any and all employees of CONTRACTOR in the minimum statutorily required coverage amounts;
  - b. Automobile Liability Insurance for each of CONTRACTOR’s vehicles used in the performance of this Agreement, including owned, non-owned (e.g. owned by CONTRACTOR’s employees or contractors), leased or hired vehicles, in the minimum amount of \$1,000,000 combined single limit per occurrence for bodily injury and property damage.
  - c. Comprehensive or Commercial General Liability Insurance coverage in the minimum amount of \$1,000,000 combined single limit, including coverage for:
    - (1) bodily injury
    - (2) personal injury
    - (3) broad form property damage
    - (4) contractual liability
    - (5) cross-liability
    - (6) products and completed operations liability
4. Other Insurance Provisions.

If any insurance coverage required in this Agreement is provided on a “Claims Made” rather than “Occurrence” form, CONTRACTOR agrees to maintain the required coverage for a period of three (3) years after the expiration of this Agreement (hereinafter “post agreement coverage”) and any extensions thereof. CONTRACTOR may maintain the required post agreement coverage by renewal or purchase of prior acts or tail coverage. This provision is contingent upon post agreement coverage being both available and reasonably affordable in relation to the coverage provided during the term of this Agreement. For purposes of interpreting this requirement, a cost not exceeding 100% of the last annual policy premium during the term of this Agreement in order to purchase prior acts or tail coverage for post agreement coverage shall be deemed to be reasonable.
5. Endorsements.

All required Automobile and Comprehensive or Commercial General Liability Insurance shall be endorsed to contain the following clauses:

  - a. The City of Visalia, its officers, agents, employees, representatives, and volunteers are added as additional insureds as respects operations and activities of, or on behalf of the named insured, performed under contract with the City of Visalia.

- b. It is agreed that any insurance maintained by the City of Visalia shall apply in excess of and not contribute with insurance provided by this policy.
- c. This insurance shall not be canceled, limited in scope or coverage, or non-renewed until after thirty (30) days prior written notice has been given to the City Clerk, City of Visalia, 707 W. Acequia, Visalia, CA, 93291

6. Proof of Coverage.

CONTRACTOR agrees to provide its insurance broker(s) with a full copy of these insurance provisions and provide CITY on or before the effective date of this Agreement with Certificate(s) of Insurance for all required coverages. Copies of all the required Endorsements shall be attached to the Certificate(s) of Insurance or other evidence of insurance acceptable to the City of Visalia, which shall be provided by CONTRACTOR's insurance company as evidence of the stipulated coverages.
