ITEM 1: EXTENSION OF BID SUBMITTAL DEADLINE

The deadline for submitting bids in response to this RFB has been extended. Bids are due no later than:

ITEM 2: QUESTIONS/RESPONSES

Q1. There are 25 working days for the base bid. Does that include striping time?

R1. Working days shall include striping time. The table in Section 60-4 is being amended to allow some additional time. Please see the changes below (in red).

Section 60-4 "Impacted Schools" is also being amended to accurately show the affected schools. Please see changes below (in red).

The Contractor shall begin work within **Ten (10) days** after receiving notice that the contract has been approved (Notice to Proceed) and shall diligently prosecute the same to final completion of the total project **Seventy (70) working days** after that work begins (mobilization). Depending on what is awarded, the Contractor shall complete the work within the following number of working days:

The Contractor shall begin work within the number of days listed above in this section after receiving notice that the contract has been approved (Notice to Proceed). The Contractor shall be responsible for obtaining the approved Encroachment Permit, submitting all of the other documents required by the City, obtaining all necessary permits, and obtaining all approvals/acceptances required for the project prior to starting construction. Should the Contractor fail to obtain the required permits and approvals within the number of days listed in this section for the beginning of work after the Notice to Proceed is issued, the length of time beyond the number of days listed will be subtracted as working days from the Contract. The Contractor shall commence work under the contract within the time specified above and shall diligently prosecute the same to completion within the time limit provided. The Contractor shall not begin work in advance of receiving the Notice to Proceed without written authorization from the Engineer. **The Contractor shall notify the Inspector and Engineer in writing a minimum of 2 working days prior to starting work.**

The contractor shall coordinate with the Engineer on scheduling construction activities during off peak times to minimize impacts to the schools.

Impacted Schools: CVC Schools, El Diamante High School, La Joya Middle School, Linwood Elementary, Visalia Montessori School, Veva Blunt Elementary, Royal Oaks Elementary, College of Sequoias, Crestwood Elementary, and Cottonwood Creek Elementary.
