

 - (c) Any available counseling, rehabilitation and employee assistance programs, and
 - (d) Penalties that may be imposed upon employees for drug abuse violations.

This Addendum is being issued to respond to questions that have been received for RFB-22-23-31 and provide mandatory pre-bid sign in sheets. This addendum becomes part of the Contract Documents for the above project and must be signed and submitted with proposal.

ITEM 1: QUESTIONS/RESPONSES

Q1. Specifications state that the Contractor will have 30 days to inspect all areas – is this billable time?

R1. The Awarded Contractor will begin work on the contracted areas on the agreed upon day with the Project Manager. Awarded Contractor will be expected to be making inspections and notations during the first 30 days of all problems that need to be addressed. Contractor is being paid for the landscape maintenance during this time and as such are on these locations weekly. It is important that the Contractor carefully inspect the areas during this timeframe and call it to the attention of the project manager as soon as possible.

Q2. For weed control - is turf spraying included? If yes, how many times per year?

R2. Yes, turf spraying is included and will be needed throughout the year as often as Contractor deems required to prevent weeds and/or kill weeds to maintain area as specified. Bidders should include spraying costs in their total monthly bid price.

Q3. What about fertilization?

R3. See Scope of Services, Item 10. Bidders SHALL NOT include fertilization costs in their bid price. All fertilization will on an as needed basis. City will request a quote for the cost of fertilizing areas when needed. If Contractor notices areas that need to be fertilized, Contractor shall bring those areas to the attention of the Project Manager at the monthly meeting.

Q4. Can we get a copy of the current contract?

R4. See Attachment 1 to this Addendum

Q5. What is the current monthly unit price being paid per square foot for the landscape maintenance of this Quadrant?

R5. See Attachment 1 to this Addendum

Q6. The sample irrigation report that is included with the bid document seems more in-depth than before.

R6. Yes, that is correct.

Q7. Will there be an Interview Process held?

R7. No, since this is a bid process, the decision is based on low price. Contract would be awarded to the lowest bidder whose proposal is deemed responsive and responsible and meets criteria listed in the bid document (licenses, certifications, etc.).

Q8. Does the low bidder get disqualified if they've done a bad job in previous contracts?

- R8. No. The City has not suspended or debarred any Contractor from bidding on City Contracts.
- Q9. Will the watering regulations be the same as they were last year? This makes it difficult on the Contractors to comply when areas are scheduled are looking dry and stressed.
- R9. As far as we know. The watering guidelines will be updated if there is a change in the regulations. The Watering guidelines have been included with your bid documents. However, for any areas that have drip irrigation watering can occur on any day except Monday.
- Q10. Can we view the City's current contracts online?
- R10. No, however if you have a question about a particular contract or want to know current price information, you can email <u>purchasing@visalia.city</u> and request information as all City Contracts are considered public information.
- Q11. Is a 10% bid guarantee required to be submitted with bid? Also, if submitting a cashier's check, can we get the check back right away if we are not the low bidder?
- R11 Yes, as stated in the Instructions on page 4 of the Bid Document. Bidder can submit this in form of Cashier's Check, Certified Check, or a Bidder's Bond.

Most Bidders obtain a Bidder's bond because if they submit a cashier's check we must hold all checks from all Bidders until a contract is awarded. That can take several weeks as these contracts require City Council approval (this adds time to the actual award and depends on when the item can be on the Council Agenda). If you submit a Cashier's check you should be aware that you will not get it back right away.

- Q12. Who is the current inspector on that side of the City?
- R12. Currently it is Julia. However, Inspectors are subject to change depending on assignment.
- Q13. Luisi 2 and 4 are not shown on the map. Can you send us that map or should we not bid those areas?
- R13. We don't have Luisi 2 or 4. What we have listed on our maps are Luisi Ranch 2 and 4.
- Q14. What is the process if our measurements differ from the data provided? For example, our estimating program calculates Luisi ranch 3 has 31,420 compared to your 20,633 for planter beds. Other example is Ashley grove 1 and 2 you have 33,673 and we measured it at 19,023 for planter beds.
- R14. The measurements we have are from when the areas were developed and were given by our engineering dept.
 - For bidding purposes, please use the measurements we have listed in this bid when making your bid. If we later determine that the areas include more square footage, those will be adjusted by the Contract pricing with the awarded contractor.
- Q15. Can we please get more details on the expectation for rodent/pest control? Are we expected to set up our own traps or hire a sub?
- R15. Rodent/pest control: If the Awarded Contractor is not performing Rodent/Pest Control Services required by this bid and is intending to subcontract this portion of work, the Subcontractor must be listed on the Subcontractor List (included with bid). The Subcontractor's valid DIR Registration number must be included. Any Substitution of Subcontractor during the Contract will need to be approved by the Project Manager and documented in the Contract. All subcontractors are expected to hold valid DIR Registration Numbers.
- Q16. Can they provide a count of battery-operated controllers?
- R15. There aren't any battery-operated controllers in "K"
- Q17. How much graffiti removal has been done historically?
- R17. We don't have any record of how much graffiti has been removed by previous contractors. However, occasionally a controller box, a park sign, botanical plaque, monument stone, stop sign, directional street sign, landscape wall, or other types of signage in the area Contractor is maintaining, will be defaced or "tagged" with graffiti or will otherwise collect dirt, dust or bird excrement. If it is easily wiped away with a wet wipe or damp towel then the Contractor is expected to do so. If it is dried paint or some type of more

permanent ink or marker, then Contractor shall immediately report it to the Project Manager. Likewise, any broken or missing signs should be reported to the Project Manager as soon as Contractor is aware.

- Q18. Do they have any information about the number of main line repairs and valve replacements that have been done in the past years? What is the current status of the irrigation system state of repair?
- R18. We don't have records of repairs they have made as they were done by contractors on an as needed basis. Systems as far as we know are fully operational. If awarded this contract, the Contractor shall have 30 days from the date contract begins to inspect and report any repairs that are needed.
- Q19. Is there a size limit to trees that we are required to remove if they die or are damaged? Is this due to contractor negligence or any reason?
- R19. If a tree needs to be removed due to Contractor's negligence, Contractor is required to remove a tree up to 2-inches in diameter, at breast height (DBH).

ITEM 2: CHANGES

Section VIII, Award and Execution of Contract, Item C, References currently reads:
 Where indicated on the Bid Forms, Bidder shall include a list of three (3) accounts, complete with locations, that have been maintained for at least three (3) years, and that are similar in size and characteristics to those listed in these contract documents.

The above section shall now be changed to read:

Where indicated on the Bid Forms, Bidder shall include a list of three (3) accounts, complete with locations, that have been maintained for at least **two (2) years**, and are similar in size and characteristics to those listed in these contract documents.

2. There are no changes to the Prevailing wages that were originally posted with the bid document.
