





Addendum is being issued to provide responses to questions. This addendum becomes part of the RFB 23-24-45 document and must be signed and submitted with bid.

ITEM 1: QUESTIONS/RESPONSES

Q1: Can bidders subcontract for heavy duty vehicle tows?

R1: **No. Subcontracting for heavy-duty vehicle tows is not permitted.**

Q2: Can we take pictures to document any damages before towing the vehicle?

R2: Tow operators may request to take photographs of a vehicle prior to towing; however, permission must first be obtained from the officer on scene who is responsible for the tow. The officer will evaluate the request and determine whether photographs are appropriate based on the nature of the incident, the sensitivity of the case, and the reason for the tow.

Q3: Is a lift required for heavy duty vehicles?

R3: No. Due to the infrequency of heavy-duty tows, it is unreasonable to require an operator to invest in a lift capable of handling such vehicles.

Q4: Who currently tows heavy duty vehicles?

R4: The City of Visalia does not have a standing contract for evidence-related heavy-duty vehicle tows. When such a service is required, the Visalia Police Department will contact a towing company capable of handling the specific heavy-duty vehicle. The vehicle is typically towed to a secure facility, such as the Visalia Emergency Communications Center (VECC) or the City Yard. The Visalia Police Department covers the cost of the tow through payment to the private towing company.

Q5: Can vehicle tow fees be charged to the registered owner when a vehicle is released by the Visalia Police Department?

R5: No, not while the vehicle is held as evidence. An evidence hold begins at the moment the Visalia Police Department determines the vehicle must be seized. During this time, the Department is responsible for all tow and storage fees. Once the vehicle is released from evidence, the registered owner becomes responsible for any applicable fees starting the next business day.
