ITEM 3: QUESTIONS/RESPONSES

- Regarding Rate increases, the contract renewal dates do not always match up with the updates to wages. Will the City work with the Contractor on this or are contract rate increases only done once per year? All prices bid are firm and fixed for 12 months. The Contractor can ask for an increase once per year at contract renewal time.
