A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF VISALIA,
ACCEPTING THE HOUSING ELEMENT ANNUAL PROGRESS REPORT FOR
CALENDAR YEAR 2024 AND FINDING THAT IT SATISFIES THE CITY'S
REPORTING REQUIREMENTS TO THE STATE

WHEREAS, the Housing Element Annual Progress Report for Calendar Year 2024 has been prepared to comply with Government Code Section 65400(a)(2) and California Department of Housing and Community Development programs, and implements Housing Element Program 9.1: Implementation Reporting in order to provide information to the City Council, the Governor's Office of Land Use and Climate Innovation, the State Department of Housing and Community Development, the Tulare County Association of Governments, and the public as to the status of the implementation of the Housing Element programs, as well as mark the city's progress in meeting its share of the region's housing needs; and

WHEREAS, the City Planner has determined that the report is categorically exempt from environmental review under California Environmental Quality Act Guidelines Section 15306, which states that information collection activities are exempt from the provisions of the act.
