Visalia Riverway Sports Park

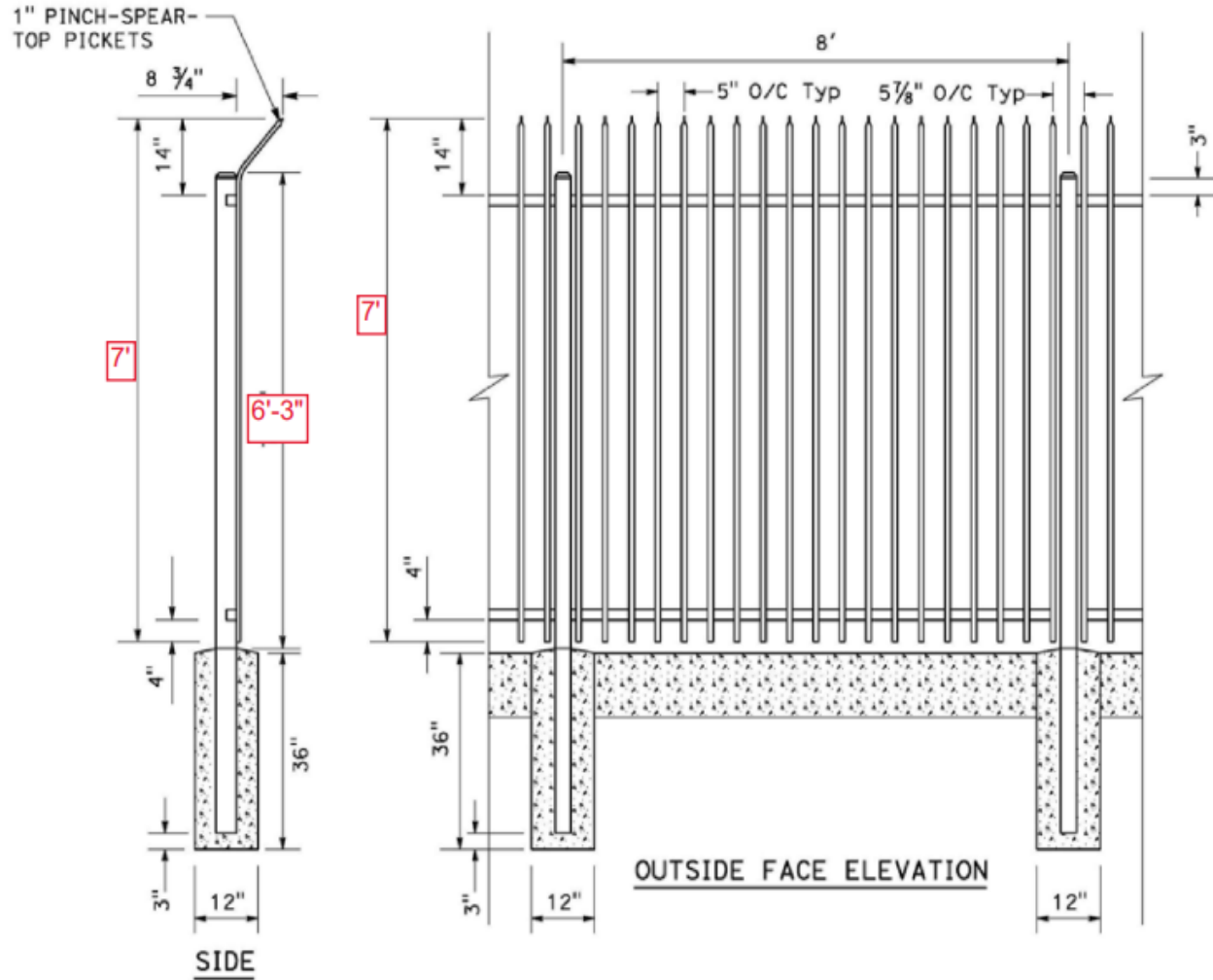
History of Riverway Sports Park

- Phase I started construction in 2006 and was completed in 2007.
- Phase II of the project started construction in 2009 and was completed in 2010.
- Phases III was started in early 2013, with phase IV being added to the project in July of 2013 and both phases completed in 2014.
- Phase V was started in early 2019 and was completed in 2020.
- Phase IV is currently in development for Riverway Sports Park

Staff is proposing 7-foot-tall wrought iron fencing for the perimeter of Riverway Sports Park

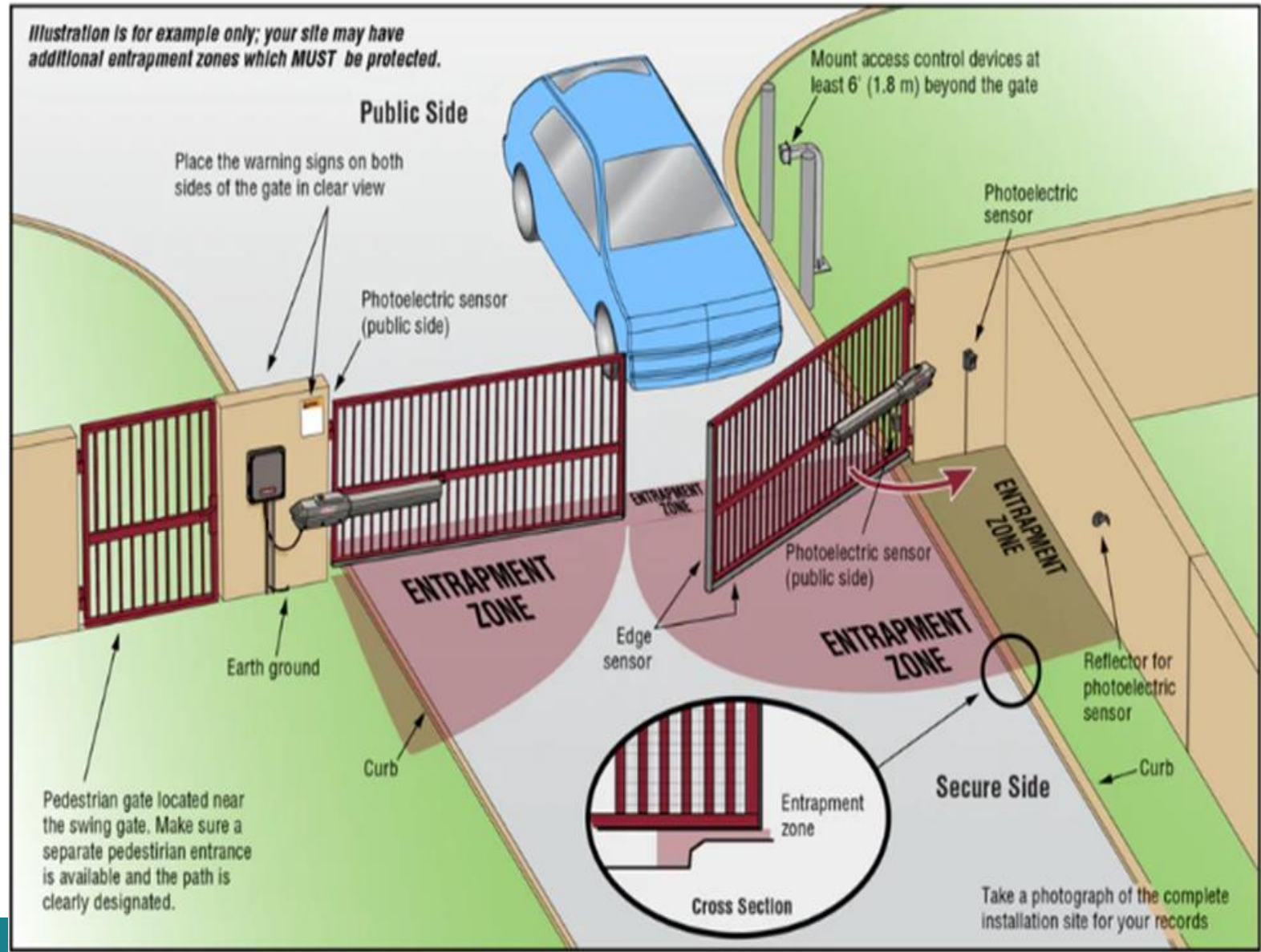


Fully Programmable Gate Openers

Gate openers will be programmable for hours of operation, able to open with a remote control, and will be able to be opened manually if a power outage occurs.

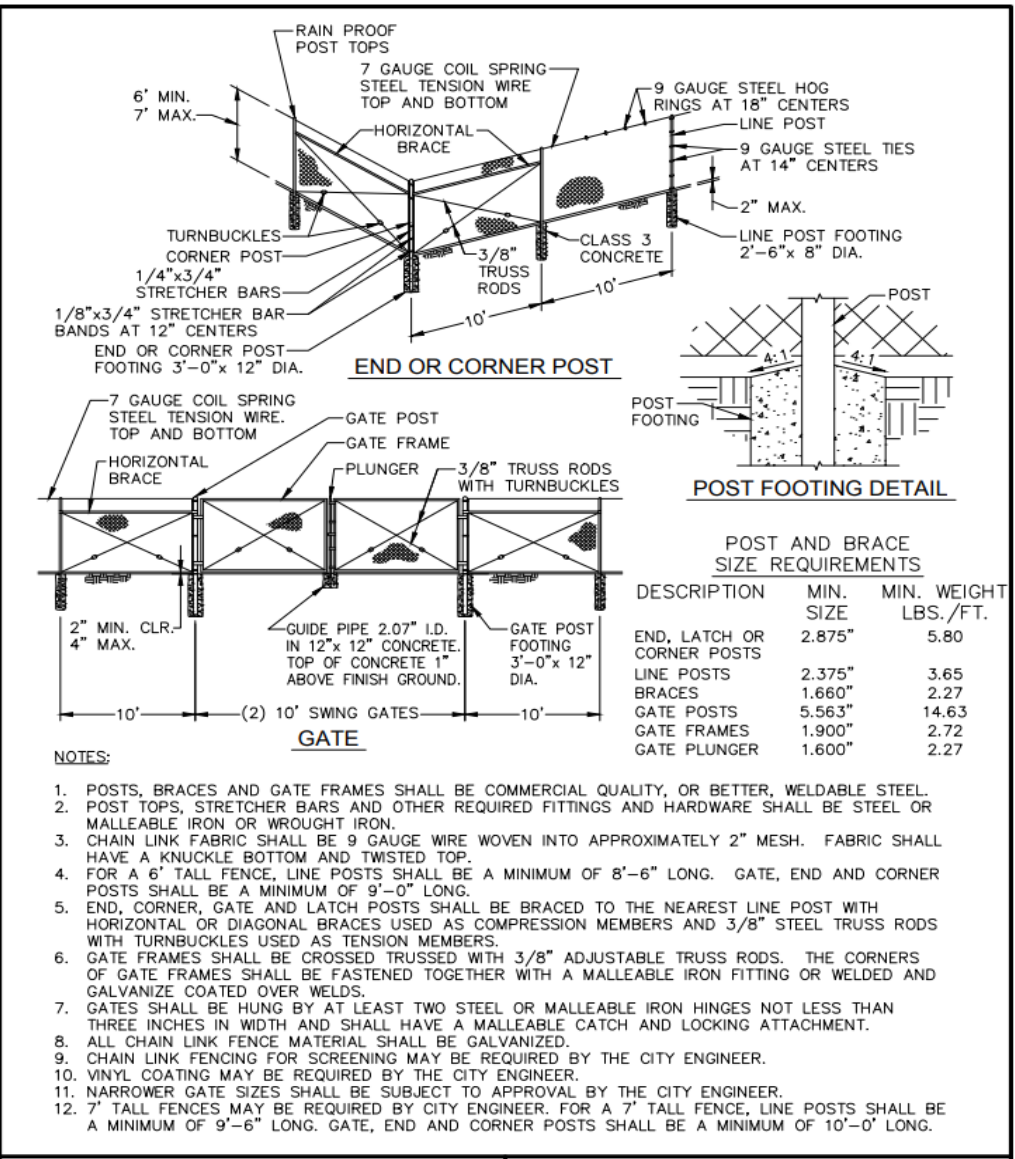
Vehicle Gate Diagram

Vehicle gates will be automated with keypad for public safety to access the park.



Chain-link for the soccer fields

Staff is proposing a black vinyl coated 7-foot chainlink for the interior of the park for the perimeter of the soccer fields. This will reduce cost and match the other amenities within the park.
